- *The braided gold cords worn by graduates of Westminster College are a mark of distinction and indicate that these students are graduating Cum Laude (with praise), Magna Cum Laude (with great praise), or Summa Cum Laude (with highest praise).*
- *The President Medal of Office is passed to each succeeding President of Westminster College. The names of the fourteen presidents are engraved on the back of the medal and each succeeding president's name will be added.*
- *The mace is a club-shaped staff used as a symbol of authority. Originally a weapon of the Middle Ages, sergeants-at-arms, who were guards of kings and other officials, carried maces. Gradually the mace gained a ceremonial character.*
- *The Salt Lake Scots Pipe Band was formed in 1962 and has been in continuous active existence since that time. The Salt Lake Scots have become an important part of Westminster College's commencement tradition. Pipe Master is Dennis McMaster.*
- *Westminster College welcomes the musical talent of the Brass by Five under the direction of Mr. Brent Christensen, french horn. Dennis Husted and Robert Hixson play trumpet; Wayne Webb, trombone; and Kim Dalby, euphonium.*
